

Workshop - related aspects of urban logistics in the project DOROTHY - FP7

On the 24 October 2014 in Craiova the Organizer University of Craiova – Faculty of Mechanics - Department of Vehicles and Transportation in collaboration with the co-organizers SC IPA SA, AROTT, Urban Control Systems and Society of Automotive Engineers of Romania has organized an Urban Logistics Workshop focused on Urban Logistics & Good Practices.

Discussions were stemmed from the innovative electrical solution with possibilities to use them in the city center and to the new ways of urban management based on new and innovative traffic solutions.
